Part I.

Introductory provisions

1. Posazavi o.p.s. provides a public beneficial service to develop and promote the region of Posazavi and
 - The tourist potential
 - Image protection of settlements and their values
 - Services in financing projects to develop the region Posazavi
 - Assessment of potential projects for the development of the region Posazavi
 - Coordination of projects and products focused on this development
 - Preparation of information and materials
 - Creation of information databanks
 - Traffic information centers focusing on coordination and development of local regions
 - Communicating with states and local governments to cooperate with the development of the region Posazavi
 - Cooperation with foreign entities and activities related to cooperation with the European Union in the development of the region Posazavi.

Posazavi o.p.s. is certified ISO 9001:2008.

2. Thames21 positions itself as a leader and innovator in finding solutions to the environmental challenges faced by waterways. It currently operates in the south east of England and is engaged in a number of environmental programmes on the river Thames, its tributaries, and rivers and canals spanning the whole of London. This facilitates a public benefit by protecting, maintaining and enhancing the nation's rivers, canals and other waterways by:
 - The removal of litter
 - Waste and debris
 - Advancing education in the plants, wildlife and ecosystems of the waterways and other related subjects whether by teaching
 - Producing materials or by conducting or commissioning research. And raising awareness of the ways in which the waterways might be protected from pollution.

Part II.

Subject of contract

The aim of this document agreement between Posazavi o.p.s. and Thames21 is to create a voluntary contract term partnerships, and establishing long-term mutual cooperation among Parties, especially in the development of environmental protection and water areas in the territory of the respected organizations, supporting and promoting the activities of partners in their country. The Contracting Parties undertake, within their capabilities to work mainly in the following areas of interest:

- Exchange information and experience
- Cultural and social events
- Holding training seminars and information campaigns
- Preparation and implementation of partnership projects
- Promotion of cooperation with other partners
- Communication and cooperation with state and local governments
- Cooperation in other areas according to current needs and possibilities of both contractual partners.

Part III.

Duration and conditions for withdrawal

1. The Contract is concluded for an indefinite term and mutual cooperation arises (becomes effective) from the date in which both parties have received and signed the contract agreement.
2. The contract is subject to change or termination at any time by written notice to either party, with a notice period of 3 months from the date of receipt of notice to the other party.

Part IV.

Change and termination of contract

1. This agreement may be amended only by written amendment and approved by the signature of both parties.
2. The draft amendment is submitted to the other Contracting Party, by the party to the contract, which intends to implement changes, namely delivery of documents with a brief and clear statement which relates to the changes in the agreement and/or and replacements.

Part V.

Other arrangements

1. The draft agreement does not constitute any liability to either side of the Contracting Parties, with regards to any possible damages to the framework of mutual cooperation. The treaty also does not constitute any memberships in any organ of any unnamed societies.
2. Parties are obliged to inform each other about the facts decisive for the performance of this contract.

Part VI.

Final provisions

1. The contracts are drawn up into Czech and into English in the original copies, one for each side with regards to both language versions. Compliance of translation is notaries.
2. Each Contracting Party shall appoint a liaison - authorized person, that:
 - receives from the other party and gives information, then it passes the statutory authority of the party, to which organization is responsible;
 - prepares the meetings of the statutory authorities of the Contracting Parties;
 - perform routine tasks affecting the performance of this contract;
 - cannot make the parties legal actions, if not itself a statutory body or if they are not equipped with a power of attorney;
 - can be changed by a unilateral legal act concluded in written form, the change is effective at the moment it is delivered to the other side;
